Your spirit will be lifted in worship and praise. A communion service will be offered near the end of the retreat.

The ***healing ministry*** was a vital part of Jesus' ministry. On the last evening there is a time for prayer as we seek God's healing for the whole person –

Spirit, Soul And Body.

However, healing may come at any time as you listen to the Word preached and taught or in the prayerful atmosphere of your small prayer and share group.

There will be time for you to relax, rest, go for a walk or enjoy other free time activities. Some have called it ***"a holiday with God"***. It is a time apart for physical and spiritual renewal in the context of Christian love and caring. Many of the Christian Ashrams have planned programs for children and teens. The whole family can be blessed by this unique holiday retreat together.

Our founder, Dr. E. Stanley Jones, world famous missionary, evangelist and author, established the Christian Ashram movement. He took the ancient ashram format and gave it Christian content, grounding the program in Jesus Christ.

- Established at Sat Tal, India in 1930
- Created for accountability, fellowship and discipleship
- Brought to North America in 1940
- Provided opportunities for deeper spiritual growth and discipleship
- Grew to 75 Christian Ashrams worldwide by the time of his death in 1973
- Continues as an effective way to authentically connect with one another and with Jesus Christ in the 21st century
